## Program Topics

MDA staff will provide details on *Pesticide Applicator Licensing and Certification*, an update on pesticide regulatory compliance, new regulations and more.

*Invasive Species and Noxious Weeds* will help you gain knowledge on categorizing and management strategies of invasive species and noxious weeds in Minnesota landscapes.

*Successful Pesticide Application* will help you select the right herbicide, fungicide or insecticide for the job based on different pesticide characteristics. To be discussed are pesticide mode of action, resistance, different types of pesticide mobility in plants, preventative vs curative products, types of residual control, and selectivity in pests.

*Patrol Your Pesticides* is an interactive session focused on professional decision-making when the right thing to do may not be clear. Real world scenarios are used to explore safety, customer relations, environmental concerns, effectiveness of treatment, and more.

*Safe Handling* will cover how to plan for a spill, what you need to know about transporting pesticides, and practices to keep yourself and the public safe when working with pesticides.

Do you know how to protect your lungs when working with pesticides? *Respirator Selection and Use* will discuss common sense approach on protecting yourself, understanding labels and using respirators when handling pesticides.
