Who must attend a 2016 Recertification Workshop in Categories E, F, I, L, or P?

Minnesota licensed pesticide applicators holding the Turf & Ornamentals (Category E)*, Aquatics (Category F), Anti-Microbial (Category I), Mosquito (Category L), and Vertebrate Pest (Category P) need to attend an MDA approved recertification workshop the year after initial certification and every two years after that.

Check the license card for expiration dates or call MDA with questions. Attending this workshop will also give recertification credit for the core certification (category A). Some license categories require recertification more or less often. Visit www.mda.state.mn.us/pesticideapplicator for more information.

When do I renew my license, attend a recertification workshop, or retest?

Licenses are valid for one calendar year; therefore, license renewal is required every year. To remain eligible for renewal, applicators must meet educational requirements by attending a recertification workshop or retesting. Contact the MDA for retesting information. If an applicator fails to attend or misses a recertification workshop, they must retest for the specific category.
