

Who must attend a Field Crop Recertification Workshop in 2016? MN pesticide applicators licensed in Categories A and C who last attended a workshop in 2013 need to attend an MDA approved recertification workshop. New pesticide applicators (licensed for the first time in 2015) need to attend a workshop, too. Attendance at an approved recertification workshop once every three (3) years fulfills the recertification requirement in Categories A and C by licensed commercial and noncommercial pesticide applicators. Some license categories require recertification more often.

When do I renew my license, attend a recertification workshop, or retest? License renewal is required every year, and follows recertification. Attending a 2016 Recertification Workshop enables pesticide applicators to renew their license in 2017, 2018, and 2019. If an applicator does not attend a 2016 workshop in their categories as required, retesting must be completed before a license can be renewed. Then, in addition to the license application fee, retest fees are charged for each category.
