| Hemlock, Canadian [Tsuga canadensis] | 40+ | 20+ | Pyramidal | Green | No | No | Yes | No | Yes | Requires a site protected from winds, full sun exposure, and well-drained soils |
| Juniper, Rocky Mountain [Juniperus scopulorum] | 15+ | 6+ | Pyramidal | Green | No | Yes | No | No | Yes | Does better than other plants on dry, rocky, or sandy soil |
| Spruce, blue (Colorado) [Picea pungens] | 30+ | 20+ | Pyramidal | Blue/Green | No | No | No | No | Yes | Nice park or yard tree if soil moisture and drainage is adequate, and plenty of sun. Prone to disease. |
