Tuesday, December 8th

TSP Nutrient and Pest Management Update for Technical Service Providers (TSP) 10 AM - 3 PM

This four hour session focuses on nutrient and pest management in wellhead protection areas and other areas with vulnerable aquifers. The target audience is TSPs certified by NRCS in nutrient and pest management.

Plenary Session 1 PM - 3 PM

Richard Gearheard has served as Senior Vice President of Agrium and President of the Retail Division since August 1996, will provide a unique ag retail expertise to address a fundamental question every ag retailer must successfully answer. His presentation is entitled: "The question is: How much profit? not...How much does it cost?" Richard will discuss and describe how the ag retailer gets the grower to ask the right question and what are the potential answers. He will also provide a brief discussion and description of global trends. You cannot afford to miss what a leader of this global ag retail giant thinks about getting to the right bottom line questions and how you move your farmer customers to ask those critical questions.

Nurse Tank/ Minibulk Information Sessions 3 PM - 4:30 PM

One session will be held in the center of the exhibit hall and the other will be held in the back of the exhibit hall. Sessions will run for 45 minutes and will be held twice. The nurse tank demonstration will run through what you need to be looking

for when inspecting your nurse tanks (markings, etc.). In the alternative session, Nancy Fitz with EPA, will perform an inspection on a minibulk, clarifying the new 2011 EPA minibulk requirements.

Election of Board members and annual meeting followed by the popular "Ice Breaker" reception held in the exhibit hall.

Wednesday, December 9th

CPM Short Course 8 AM - 5 PM

The CPM Short Course's General Session will continue with this year's theme "Possibilities and Probabilities". Drs. Paula Davis and Laura Higgins, James Specht and Antonio Mallarino will present and discuss perspectives on corn insect trait development and risk management, possibilities of doubling soybean yields by 2030, and the alternatives for phosphorus soil-test interpretations and fertilizer application respectively. The concurrent sessions in the afternoon will expand further on the morning program.

Pesticide Applicator Recertification 8:30 AM - 5 PM

If you are a licensed applicator with Categories A (Core) and C (Field Crop Pest Management) who last attended a recertification workshop in 2006, or a new licensed pesticide applicator in 2008, you must attend an MDA-approved workshop in 2009 or retest to renew your license in 2010. This Pesticide Applicator Recertification workshop has been approved by the Minnesota Department of Agriculture (MDA). Applicators must attend all sessions of the Recertification Track and complete the onsite documentation to obtain recertification credit. Bring your license ID card to workshop. Attendance will be monitored by MDA. Recertification will be denied by MDA if you arrive late or miss substantial portions of the workshop. Applicators can renew on-line at www.mda.state.mn.us. Thursday's concurrent sessions continue the strong educational program with a wealth of pest, crop, and fertilizer management topics including; possibilities of growing 300 bushel per acre corn consistently, herbicide resistant weed management, the

management of corn residue for corn and soybeans, seed placed fertilizer guideline software, corn fungicide response in the midwest, and probabilities of a response to foliar fertilizer in corn and soybeans.
