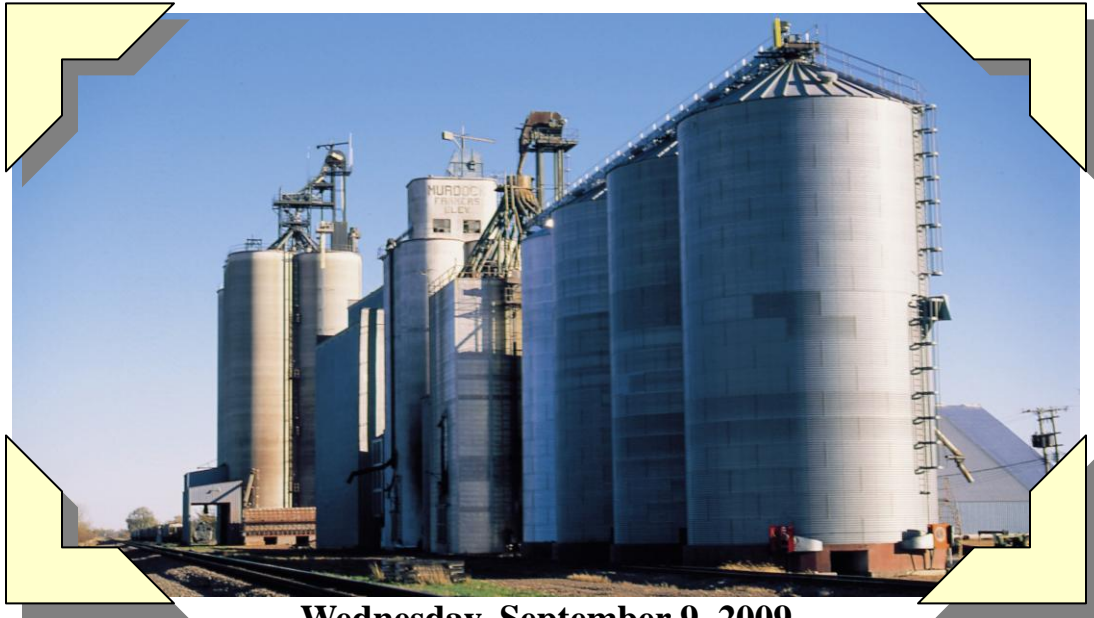

## **Need To Be Licensed and Certified?**

Persons applying Restricted Use Pesticides are required by Minnesota Law to be licensed annually and recertified every 2 years. Attendance at the scheduled Stored Grain Pest Management Conference fulfills recertification requirements for pesticide applicators licensed in categories A (Core), N (Stored Grain and Fumigation) and M (Food Processing Pest Control). Attendance may also help prepare unlicensed persons for the exam.

## **License Renewal**

Commercial and noncommercial applicators must recertify every two years. Attending this workshop will recertify you in Categories A and N for 2010 and 2011. For workshop questions, contact the Minnesota Grain and Feed Association at 651-454-8212.

## **Attendance Requirement**

Workshop participants must be present for the entire program to receive recertification credit. Applicators should bring their license identification card with them to the workshop. Attendance will be monitored. The Minnesota Department of Agriculture reserves the right to deny recertification credit to participants who arrive later than 30 minutes after the start of the program, or who are absent during substantial portions of the program.
