2016 STATE FAIR 4-H POULTRY SHOWMANSHIP

St. Paul, MN (8/25/16) – 241 outstanding young people were honored at this year’s Minnesota 4-H Poultry Show for their showmanship ability. The showmanship competition held on Aug. 25, 2015 at the Minnesota State Fair, is based on the 4-H’er’s knowledge of poultry production, grooming skills and handling techniques. Because of a large number of participants in the poultry projects, some of the age groups were split into multiple classes. The judges for the showmanship contests were: Wayne Fischer from Arlington, South Dakota, Bart Pals from Mason City, Iowa and Zeb Skow from Wesley, Iowa. The champion winners in each are listed below.
